The user agrees to abide by Art. 29 EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and not to process personal data except on instructions from AIDA Cruises. The user will observe any security measures and instructions of AIDA Cruises regarding data handling. These instructions include, without limitation, the Data Protection Policy, the Data Breach Policy and the applicable IT End User Policy (Ship/Shore) of AIDA Cruises. The relevant regulations and obligations to confidentiality are known, in particular:

- The personal data that the user is entrusted with must only be processed within the scope of the user's work tasks and will not be passed on to unauthorised persons without permission.
- The hardware and software provided to the user as well as the password must be kept inaccessible by unauthorized persons.
- All internal company information made available throughout the fulfilment of the tasks for AIDA Cruises is not to be disclosed.
- It is understood that the obligations mentioned are to be further observed after completion of the tasks.
